SETTING THE STAGE FOR SUCCESSFUL IMPLEMENTATION

Ensuring all users have opportunities to learn about the DESSA through training opportunities is necessary for a successful implementation. Below you'll find some helpful tips to consider as you select the training option(s) that work best for your program or district.



Why is completing training before using the DESSA so important? It's simple—to be confident and prepared! Training provides users with a clear understanding of how to use the assessment products and instructional materials. This step in the implementation process is essential to ensure accuracy and reliability. DESSA Training helps users understand how to collect and interpret data, and avoid potential errors or biases. Training is recommended throughout the school year as data is collected and used to support student growth.

ESTABLISH A TIMELINE FOR TRAINING

Consider which timeframes throughout the year that training can be prioritized, such as before/at the beginning of the school, before completing ratings, after collecting data, and after progress monitoring to measure the impact of instruction and intervention.



ENSURE ACCESS TO THE DESSA SYSTEM

It is recommended that all users have access to their DESSA System Educator Portal prior to completing a form of training. Some training options are available within the DESSA System, while others will require users to follow along in their Educator Portal as part of the session.

DETERMINE THE MODALITY

We offer a variety of training options, including DESSA Training Courses (included in purchase), Virtual Webinars (customized sessions for purchase), and On-Site Workshops (customized sessions for purchase).
