Scholarship Requirements and Process

The purpose of this scholarship is to assist graduate students with costs associated with university-program-related expenses (e.g., tuition, travel to a conference, educational technology purchases, other professional development, or research costs). A scholarship nomination is required as a part of the application process after the first year.



Scholarship Amount:

\$5,000 / year

Deadline for Submission:

Oct 1, 2026

Nomination Process

Students must be nominated by a UTP professor. To qualify for nomination the student must have a 3.5 GPA or higher and be studying to become an evaluator/educator (e.g., school psychologist, educational diagnostician, neuropsychologist, psychologist, or special education teacher). The nomination will be embedded in the UTP application so professors can nominate a student at the same time that they reapply for the program.

Information provided by the professor:

- Student's Name
- Student's Email Address
- University Affiliation
- Student's program of study
- Brief statement explaining why the student is being nominated (e.g., why does this student deserve to receive the scholarship? What are his/her accomplishments?)

Nominated students* must submit the following information to be considered for the scholarship:

- Letter of Intent – outlining professional goals and why you should be awarded this scholarship
- Proof of strong GPA (3.5 or higher) - unofficial transcript
- Copy of Curriculum Vitae
- Demonstrate use of BDI-3, WJ IV, or WJ V in research or project (must submit research/article demonstrating use) – share research proposal (e.g., dissertation, conference proposal, abstract)
- Must complete UTP survey – what is missing from university preparation of assessments? What are your future professional plans? Etc.

*Nominated students will receive an email to submit the required information.
